Parks Division

The City of Holland Parks Division is responsible for:

- Maintaining City parks, open areas, tot lots, and streetscape landscaping
- Planting and maintaining tulip beds, lanes, and boulevards
- Provides backdrop for Holland's annual Tulip Time Festival
- Trimming, planting, and removal of trees in the public park system and the public right-of-way

Cemetery

The City of Holland Cemetery Division exists to:

- To provide a final resting place for the deceased, with an atmosphere of consolation for the living. Interments may be made by burial or burial of cremains.
- Perpetual Care of cemetery plots

Holland Municipal Stadium

The City of Holland Municipal Stadium is a city-owned facility used for sporting contests and other special events which the City will:

- Provide a safe, attractive facility for sports, games, and special events
