DESCRIPTION This two story red brick flat roof gymnasium has a one story section that is treated with glass block and multilight rectangular windows. The six bay two story section is decorated with vertical buttress piers that separate the multilight double hung sash windows. A corbeled brick cornice unifies the facade.

HISTORY The building was used as a gymnasium until 1990 when it was converted into offices for community education.
