The City of Holland is temporarily cancelling all [Holland Recreation](#) events until further notice in response to the Governor’s and Ottawa County Department of Public Health recommendations to slow the spread of (COVID-19) by cancelling large gatherings. The Koffie Kletz scheduled for Saturday, March 14, 2020, at Windmill Island Gardens has also been cancelled.
