A QUICK GUIDE to the City of Holland Bike Network

What are SHARROWS?

 “Sharrows” or (shared lane markings) guide cyclists to the best place on the street to ride. They also remind motorists to share the lane with cyclists.

What is a Multi-Use Path?

Multi-Use Paths are separate from the road. Anyone can use them, cyclists, joggers, dog walkers and everyone else. Be courteous and go slow.

What is an On Street Bike Lane?

 On Street Bike Lanes are designated areas for bikes to ride on the street identified by white lines and a bike symbol.

What does Share the Road mean?

Cyclists share the road with motorists. There are no designated bike lanes outlined.
