The City of Holland has begun planning for the 2021-22 *Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)* program year. The CDBG program provides funding for activities and programs which principally benefit low-income persons and promote the development of viable communities.

The City seeks to engage residents, representatives from neighborhood development, human service and faith-based organizations, and other interested persons in order to obtain input and feedback on how the program might best address identified needs and opportunities in the community.

Two web-based meetings are planned for this purpose. The meetings will consist of a presentation on the CDBG program followed by conversation regarding relevant community needs and opportunities.
