The City of Holland has begun planning for the 2023-24 *Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)* program year. The CDBG program provides funding for activities and programs which principally benefit low- to moderate-income persons and promote the development of viable communities.

The City would like to obtain input from city residents and representatives from neighborhood development, human service, and faith-based organizations on how the program might best address identified needs and opportunities in the community.

Two in-person meetings are planned for this purpose. The meetings will consist of a presentation on the CDBG program and related initiatives, followed by conversation regarding relevant community needs and opportunities.

You are invited to attend either of these meetings. Each meeting will conclude with a **public hearing**, which is a formal opportunity for you to register your comments.
