Reminder to Return Absentee Ballots

Holland, MI – The City Clerk’s office is reminding residents to return their absentee ballot. If a resident chooses to vote via absentee, those ballots need to be returned to Holland City Hall. Absentee ballots may be returned at any time up until Election Day.

Residents may return their absentee ballot one of three ways:

1. Mail your absentee ballot to 270 S. River Avenue, Holland, MI 49423
2. Put your absentee ballot in the secured Ballot Drop Box at City Hall. There are two ballot drop boxes: one inside the lobby and one outside in the parking lot.
3. Put your absentee ballot in the secured Ballot Drop Box at Holland Board of Public Works Service Center, 625 Hastings Avenue, Holland, MI 49423

If you choose to return your absentee ballot via mail, you need to allow time for it go through the postal service and be delivered to Holland City Hall by Tuesday, November 5. Holland City Clerk, Brenda Katerburg, stated “The earlier residents can return their absentee ballot either to one the City’s secured drop boxes or via the mail, the better. Our staff is processing ballots daily.”

The latest date absentee ballots may be returned is Tuesday, November 5 at 8:00pm. Polls will be open 7:00am – 8:00pm on Election Day, Tuesday, November 5. For questions, contact the Clerk’s Office at clerk@cityofholland.com OR 616-355-1301.
