- Resident of the State of Michigan

**City of Holland Headlee Override Millage Ballot Proposition**

Shall the authorized charter millage for the City of Holland, established at 17.5 mills (\$17.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to 14.4480 mills (\$14.45 per \$1,000 of taxable value), by the required millage rollbacks, be increased in an amount not to exceed 3.052 (\$3.05 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to restore the full amount of the original authorized charter rate for each year in perpetuity, as a new additional millage in excess of the limitation imposed by Michigan Compiled Laws section 211.34d, to provide funds for general operating purposes? The estimated additional Ad Valorem tax revenue that the City will collect if the maximum millage is authorized and levied by the City in the 2026 calendar year is approximately \$5,221,585.
