This will be Nathan Bocks' fourth term as Mayor for the City of Holland. This will be Tim Vreeman's second term as a Council member for Ward 1. Scott Corbin will be serving his third term for Ward 5. It will be a first term serving as Holland City Council members for Tim Marroquin serving Ward 3 and Abby Klomparens serving At-Large. The Mayor serves a two-year term. City Council members serve a four-year term.
