The City of Holland has begun planning for the **2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)** program year. The CDBG program provides funding for activities and programs which benefit low- to moderate-income persons and promote the development of viable communities.

The City would like to obtain input from city residents, as well as representatives from neighborhood development, human service, and faith-based organizations on how the program might best address identified needs and opportunities in the community through strategic investments.
